LOCATION: Canton McKinley R&P Club 5527 Tyro St NE, Canton, OH 44721

ELIGIBILITY: Open to any individual (CMP Rules 2.0-2.11).

ENTRIES: Entries in individual events MUST be made by using the enclosed Registration Entry Form or by completing the online entry form. Payment may be made on the web-site or by check or money order mailed with the entry. Make checks payable to CMRPC. Slots will not be held without a completed registration form and payment (unless special arrangements are made)! Circle the number of each event in which you wish to fire. Be sure to indicate your correct CMP member ID number, or non-member classification number, Classification, and Category. Please provide an e-mail address (if available) and telephone number. Relay preferences will be honored, if possible, based on date of receipt of entry form. Confirmation will be made by email or only if the competitor encloses a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard.

ENTRY CLOSE: Individual match entries must be received no later than Friday July 3, 2026.

ENTRY LIMIT: Entries are limited to 204 competitors.

POST ENTRIES: Post entries will be accepted up to the stated limit of the range, provided such entries will not require special relays. Post entry competitors will be placed on the available relay.

FEES:

CMP Registration & Match Fees: \$25.00 (Includes special "Competitor Membership" in CMRPC).

Individual Matches: \$50.00 per gun plus registration and match fee.

Three gun package Fee: \$150.00 (Includes special "Competitor Membership" in CMRPC). Juniors \$75.00.

Post Entry Fee: \$5.00

EIC Service pistol Match: \$25.00 (Ammunition supplied by competitor)

.22 EIC Match: \$25.00 (Ammunition supplied by competitor)

EIC Revolver Match: \$25.00 (Ammunition supplied by competitor)

Note: Juniors pay 50% of regular individual fees for CMP Matches. EIC match fees are not discounted.

Entry fees will not be refunded unless cancellation is received by 6:00 pm July 3, 2026.

RULES: 27th Edition CMP Pistol Competition Rules will govern. Eye and Hearing Protection as well as Safety Flags [formerly called Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI)] are required.

SOUVENIR AWARD: Each competitor will be issued a new regional souvenir or their choice from existing inventory.

CLASSIFICATION: CMP classification system will be used in all matches. Competitors who do not have a CMP classification may compete with their current NRA classification (Rule 3.11.6). Individuals who have not been classified will fire in the Master class (Rule 3.11.7).

CHALLENGES: A challenge fee of \$2.00 will be charged for each challenge made.

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Squadding information will be issued from the Statistical Office. Squadding tickets will be ready for pick-up Wednesday evening. Competitors should call for these tickets when they arrive. CMP or NRA classification cards must be exhibited before issue of squadding tickets. A competitor who fails to obtain her / his squadding tickets, or who fails to present herself / himself at the proper firing point when her / his relay is called may lose her / his right to compete in that event. Note: Persons shooting a 900 or 1800 only will be squadded on 3rd relay. Choice of relay is not guaranteed.

AWARDS:

.22 EIC Match: Match #17 (Furnished by Civilian Marksmanship Program)

EIC Revolver Match: Match #18 (Furnished by Civilian Marksmanship Program)

EIC Service Pistol Match: Match #19 (Furnished by Civilian Marksmanship Program)

Canton McKinley R&P Club will furnish all other awards - Awards will consist of cash award.

Class/Category Awards:

Separate class awards will be given in each of three categories; Civilian (Rule 2.6.2a), Police (Rule 2.6.3d), and Service [Rules 2.6.4 a)-e)]. There must be at least four (4) entries in a category or it will be combined within the same class as follows: Service > Police > Civilian Classes with fewer than four (4) competitors will be combined with the next higher class. Open Award winners are not removed from the competitor count. There must be a minimum of four (4) in a class and category for a first place or special award, ten (10) or greater fraction for a second place, Twenty (20) or greater fraction for a third place. Additional awards will be given at the rate of one for every ten (10) additional competitors.

Match #19 CMP EIC Service Pistol Match - National Match Course. Ammunition must be furnished by the competitor. All regulations as set down by the CMP will govern this match.

MATCH CONDITIONS: Each match must be fired during the time period designated for that match. Scoring will be done down range. Competitors will score the target on their left. Competitors are responsible for repairing their own targets. Scorers and competitors shall sign and turn in their score cards at the end of

each caliber fired within fifteen minutes of completion of the match or the competitor will get a DNF (this will be strictly enforced). Range personnel will assist in all ways possible to avoid unnecessary delays. Slow fire re-fires may be fired on the subsequent relay (if space is available) or after the second relay. A challenge period shall apply after posting of preliminary results for each relay. Time for the end of the challenge period will be listed at the time of posting.

No pistols are to be pointed above the backstop.

RANGE FACILITIES:

During the tournament the Canton McKinley R&P clubhouse provides sanitary facilities and showers. Hot meals are available for purchase. Camping is permitted on the club grounds with ample space for tents and trailers. A limited number of spaces have electrical hook-ups, but no water or sanitary hook-ups are available. Competitors can arrange camping with the Match Director. A donation of at least \$5.00/day for tents and \$20/day for RVs is requested from those camping at the range. The picnic shelter and outdoor grills are available for use.

ENTERTAINMENT:

On Thursday, July 10, 2025 a Steak "Fry" with salad, potatoes, baked beans, and rolls. be held after firing is finished. You may purchase a dinner ticket (\$25) with your entry or that afternoon.

BBQ: On Friday July 11, 2025 a BBQ with coleslaw, baked beans, roll and desert will be held after firing is finished. You may purchase a dinner ticket (\$25) with your entry or that afternoon. Proceeds benefit the ORPA Junior Pistol Team. BYOB.

The traditional kielbasa cookout with door prizes will be held Saturday July 12th evening after firing is finished. All competitors and workers are invited for this social event. BYOB.

MEALS: Breakfast (eggs, bacon, potatoes, toast, juice and coffee) will be served from 6:30 am until 11:00 am.

Lunch will be ala carte with items listed along with suggested minimum donations. With coffee, iced tea or lemonade provided at no charge. Lunch will be served from 11:30 am until 3:00 pm.

Bags of ice, Klondikes, and drumsticks will be sold ala carte.
